POSTER MANICURE | NATURAL NAILS, ONE-COLOUR OR FRENCH FINISH (NO ART)

TASK & TIME & GOAL

- 1. Not a floor/live competition picture (jpeg/tiff file) & text need to be sent to the organiser prior to the deadline.
- 2. It is the 'whole picture' that will be judged, not just the work on the nails. Points will be awarded for the manicure finish & overall 'wow' factor. The style, background & theme of the picture will also be judged. Think 'magazine cover' when creating this poster.
- A written synopsis of no more than 50 words in English must be provided with your photograph detailing how the look was achieved. This
 is for the judges to mark complexity & understand the journey to completed look. Please note points will be deducted for failing to include
 the text.
- 4. One or two hands, short, square, oval, almond elegant nails to be showcased in one colour, French can be in colour or a mix of colours or natural. No nail art to be added.
- 5. NOTE: Can you see the nails clearly? Points are lost if the judges cannot see the nails clearly. They need to judge the quality of the finish of the manicure.
- 6. All entries must be new to *Nailympia* & can only be entered one time in this competition. Must be an original photograph that has not been previously published or displayed in public, seen in any format/place or on social media.
- 7. Image must be in colour. No black & white or sepia.
- 8. All designs must be original & not seen in previous competitions or images.
- 9. Must not use nails designed or published previously.

ALLOWED

- 1. Finish on nails can be in nail polish or gel polish.
- 2. Only 1 photograph is required.

NOT ALLOWED

- 1. All entries must be new to Nailympia & can only be entered one time. No repeat entries from prior years allowed.
- 2. No faces only hand or hands in the photo.
- 3. No black & white or sepia image.
- 4. The work must not have been published, on social media or entered any competition or published in any journal beforehand.
- 5. No entries that have been changed from previous competitions allowed.
- 6. A maximum of ONE entry per competitor is allowed.
- 7. No nail extensions. Do not use UV hard gel or L&P acrylic systems to extend the nail.
- 8. No nail art to be added.

TIP

Read the content of the score sheets. Check out the point distribution. Where you will gain the most points & where you gain the least. This will help your timing & focus. Knowledge of where you can gain points & where you can unnecessarily lose them is helpful.

E MAIL DOCUMENTS

Every location will have its own submission system please check with the host how this is to be submitted.

Enter – One photo taken with no light reflection of the complete work. This means only 1 photo is required. (Photo size minimum 2MB / maximum 10MB.) Create a word document with your description of your work. Send everything in, to info@signaturenail.com (before the deadline). Please send everything in one or max. 2 emails, include your competitor's name & the category for Germany.

IMPORTANT, PLEASE NOTE

- Score sheets will be sent via email within 2 weeks after the Nailympia event takes place.
- Results will be announced during the ceremony of the arena event.
- The Nailympia team & organiser supports the decisions made by host & judges.
- There will no longer be judges critique on any nails or score sheets at the close of any Nailympia event.
- You are welcome to ask judges what they think about your work, if the nails are still on.
- The criteria rules & the score sheets are on an international standard. If you need more specific information, please feel free to download the guidelines on www.nailympia.com (London global website).

SCORE SHEET CONTENT

JUDGE 1

- INSTANT IMPACT (10): Does the image have a 'wow factor that commands attention? Are your eyes drawn to the nails in the overall image?
- CLARITY OF IMAGE & NAILS (10): Is the image finished professionally without too much post-production work that makes it look contrived & unrealistic? No digitising of the image or addition of AI elements.

JUDGE 2

- **OVERALL STYLING (10):** Have all the elements of the image been considered & well executed with thought & consideration regarding props, model choice, the nails etc. Is the hand styling strong, powerful with a magnetic draw for the eye?
- ORIGINALITY (10): It must be an original interpretation; unusual & creative. Do you feel this is a new & exciting direction for nail imagery?

JUDGE 3

- USE OF COLOUR & LIGHTING (20): Is the use of lighting clever? Has it added depth, dimension, highlights & shadows to the frame to bring the story to life? Has the lighting affected the overall feel & projection of the image & the observer's response to it?
- EXECUTION OF CONCEPT (20): Assessing the styling, props, overall look & nail design, has the whole image been well brought together as an idea? Does it work as a nail image?

JUDGE 4

- NAIL FINISH (10): Is the nail finish beautiful, talented, creative, sharp, clean, crisp & skilled? (Glossy or matte depending on the intention of the creator). Pay close attention to the cuticle area & surrounding skin to observe the precision of the result.
- **PROFESSIONAL PRESENTATION (10):** Does this image work as a nail magazine cover? Does it speak for & represent the professional nail industry in an authentic, true yet exciting fashion?
